Policy

To ensure that members of our school community are directed to the most appropriate person to assist them, the information below outlines key contacts for common queries:

- To report a student absence, please contact the Attendance Officer, Jody Carr in the general office on extension 441
- To report any urgent issues relating to a student on a particular day, please contact the general office on extension 404, who will inform and refer to the appropriate staff member
- To discuss a student's academic progress, health and wellbeing, please contact their head of house
- To raise a concern, please contact a member of the Principal team
- For parent payments, please contact Linda Smith on extension 404
- For all other enquiries, please contact our office on 9719 1200 or extension 441

School staff will do our best to respond to general enquiries as soon as possible and ask that you allow us 2-3 working days to provide you with a detailed response. We will endeavor to respond to urgent matters within 24-48 hours where possible.
